Church Railing



3 pieces to this railing. 16ft, 11ft, and there is a swinging gate that is roughly 5ft. each piece has somewhat of a curve to it, they are not straight pieces.

All quarter-sawn oak. stands 20-21 inches tall
These pieces date back to around late 20's or 30's.

There is a 5' swinging gate section

Choir Loft Railing



2 pieces of choir loft railing. wainscoting on both sides. both pieces are roughly 11.5 ft. long



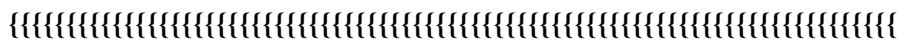

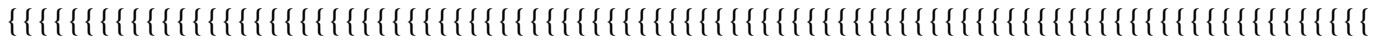
roughly 30" across



Church Bell



A 1900s Cast Iron Church Bell, complete with bell, yoke, clapper, stand and pulley (pulley wheel)
Measures 25 1/2" Diameter, Wheel measures 26" in diameter
The Number 26 is on the yoke



Copper Cross



This came from a church cemetery. Measures roughly 6ft tall by 4ft 6" wide. made from copper

Church Benches



There are 7-8 of these left, they came from a church and were original to the building which dated back to 1867.
these benches can be cut into lengths of 4, 5, or 6 ft.
I think they are made of poplar wood, the only kind that was available for that period



Chestnut-liturgical wainscoting 6" x 45" T & G - 200 pieces 3/4" thick



9 Matching Windows

Roughly 8'-9' tall- These are still in place, ready for careful removal



**Confessional Booth came from old church in New Mexico
Wooden pegs, no nails used
Spanish Colonial period**




A church Altar 16ft tall x 8ft wide x 36" deep, very ornate

HERE are a few old time Church Bell Codes

- ↪ Church bells rang at 7 A.M. at 12 noon and 9 P.M. (CURRENT)
- ↪ Deaths were tolled: 6 bells for a woman, 9 for a man. After a pause, the deceased's age was tolled in bells.
- ↪ Births tolled after 7 A.M. tolling.
- ↪ After 9 P.M. (curfew toll) the day of the month in bells was rung (10 bells for the 10th etc.)
